On 5/28/17 I responded to a suspicious person call at Keys Residential Complex. Per the reporting party there were ten individuals near Flavet Field and at least one of them was armed. Due to the call notes I responded to the call in as expeditious a manner as I safely could.

Upon arrival at Keys nothing appeared atypical. At that time UPD Communications advised that the weapon that the reporting person had seen was what appeared to be an assault rifle. Due to the lack of proximity to my vehicle, I did not deploy my department-issued patrol rifle. Multiple officers searched the area, to include Springs Complex, but nothing out of the ordinary was noted. Several pedestrians in the area all stated that they had not seen or heard anything unusual.

Ofc. McIntosh and Sgt. Lamb interviewed the reporting party and discovered that he had a video of the incident. The video matches what the reporting person described to the call taker. Several athletic looking individuals can be seen in the video. One large black male wearing all black can be seen holding what appears to be a sub-machine gun. Another tall black male in a light colored shorts can be seen holding what appears to be a rifle. There is another black male wearing a black hoodie-style jacket. There is a lightning bolt graphic on the back of the jacket. There is another black male that can be seen running in the video wearing a black shirt and orange shorts.

Ofc. McIntosh requested my assistance in locating any evidence that the weapons seen in the video were airsoft/BB guns. While searching Flavet Field with Lt. Streukens and Sgt. Lamb I observed a black male wearing a black shirt and orange shorts. This individual matched the description of one of the subjects in the video. The man was walking with another individual that was wearing a white tank top style shirt and light shorts. He also matched the description of a subject in the video. Both men entered Building 6 of Keys through the south entrance and entered the first apartment on the east. I could then see someone looking out the window at us on the Field.

While talking to Housing employees in the Keys parking lot four black males walked out of Keys. Rick Wells was wearing a black hoodie-style jacket that matched the individual in the video. Kemore Gamble was wearing a black shirt and orange shorts that matched the individual in the video. Emory Jones was wearing a light shirt and shorts that matched the individual in the video. Jones's hair also matched that of the subject in the video. Tyrie Cleveland was also present.

I read all the men the Miranda Warning from my department-issued card and interviewed them

separately. They all stated that they were playing "2K" and watching the basketball game between the Warriors and Rockets. They all denied going outside to see the scene or any involvement. When confronted with the information that there was a video that showed them, they all maintained their stories.

The video was attached to this report.

My BWC was activated during this incident.

This report reflects the extent of my involvement in this call for service.

On 5/28/2018 at approximately 21:51 hours, I was dispatched to the Keys Residential Complex on the University of Florida Campus in reference to a suspicious person. According to UFPD Dispatch, the Complainant Kingsley Lurer stated he saw approximately ten (10) people arguing and thinks they had guns. Lurer told dispatch the weapons resemble assault rifles and that the subjects looked like gang members wearing all black. Lurer stated the subjects were in south parking lot that borders Flavet Field.

While enroute the incident UFPD Dispatch was still taking the information about the incident. Dispatch advised responding officers of the new call notes and I requested emergency traffic and I expedited my response in a safe manner.

Upon arrival, I entered the back parking lot from Woodlawn Drive and did not see any group of subjects matching the reporting person's information. I drove to the east side of the parking lot near Building 10 and still did not see any group of people. Due to not identifying any people matching the initial complaint, I got out on foot and began walking the area. I saw two students who were entering Building 10 they advised they did not see any group of men in the area. Officers who were arriving on scene began walking the Keys Complex to check if the group was hiding. The walking search yielded negative results for any subjects matching the descriptions.

I asked if the Lurer could step outside and meet with me. Lurer stated there was a big group of men

that looked like a gang yelling in the parking lot. Some of the men were shirtless while the others were dressed in black. Lurer, who seemed panicked, stated he saw some of the men carrying assault style weapons. Lurer stated he saw cars parked in the parking lot and near the street. Lurer stated he called UFPD once he saw the weapons and did not watch the incident further.

While speaking to Lurer, another Keys resident Sebastian Puga stepped out and wanted to speak with me about the incident. Puga stated that he recorded the incident on his cell phone. Puga pulled out his phone and showed me a video that was approximately one (1) minute in length.

The video shows two groups of men approximately 10 -15 individuals. Part of the group was dressed in white shirts some dressed in all black. The group were outside in the Keys complex south parking lot behind Building 7. In the video there are a multiple vehicles parked on Woodlawn that were stationary and their vehicle lights were on. One of the groups dressed in black were visibly seen on the recording carrying a variety of weapons. One male in gray shorts and no shirt who had his hair up was seen carrying a long rifle weapon. Another subject is seen carrying an object that resembles a frying pan. A black male wearing a black short sleeve shirt and black shorts is seen running into the camera footage carrying a weapon. The male enters Flavel Field raises the weapon to his shoulder, in a firing manner, he pauses for a second before he and starts walking towards the other individuals. While walking he again shoulders the weapon pointing it towards the area of the other group. All of a sudden, the group begins to run towards the parking lot and into the Keys Complex, while the other group flees the area and the cars leave.

In the video, the shirtless black male is seen raising a weapon and pointing it towards the individuals in white shirts on Flavel Field. The male has his hair in a bun on his head. Additionally in the video there is a male subject wearing a black shirt that has a lightning bolt on the back of it. Another male is seen wearing a black shirt and orange gym style shorts.

Based off of the video, I walked the area of Flavel Field looking for additional evidence that weapons were discharged on the field. I walked the northwest corner near the baseball cage with Sgt. Lamb and Ofc. Bain. We could not locate any evidence that would indicate firearms or B.B. guns were discharged on Flavel Field.

While, Ofc. Bain and Sgt. Lamb were looking for evidence they spotted a black male in a black shirt and orange shorts inside of Building 6 of the Keys. The black male was walking with another male wearing a white tank top and gray shorts. Ofc. Bain asked to watch the video and says that two males entered an apartment inside building 6 and then was looking through the blinds at Ofc. Bain and Sgt. Lamb.

Ofc. Bain, Sgt. Lamb, and I walked around the north side of Building 6 where a group of four black men were exiting the building. Ofc. Bain stopped the men and began to talk to each of them. See Ofc. Bain's

supplement for more information.

While he was speaking to the males individually, it was discovered that Emory Jones was wearing a white tank top style shirt and gray shorts. Kemore Gamble was wearing orange shorts and a black shirt. While, Rick Wells was wearing a black jacket with a lightning bolt. All of these subjects were matching individuals that were in the video. Another male in the group was identified as Tyrie Cleveland.

Both Cleveland and Wells have prior incident reports from 2016 with UFPD. They were charged with criminal mischief for discharging a B.B. gun that caused property damage at the Keys Complex.

UF Residential Housing was notified and a GHD and On-Call RA responded to the scene. They were briefed about the incident and provided the case number. Additionally, due to the similarities between people involved and the residents that were interviewed, I requested from the GHD that UF Housing Security compile footage of building entry points at the keys. This footage has not been received by UFPD at the time of this written report.

The frying pan that was located on Flavet Field was collected and placed into UFPD Evidence. An analysis flag has been placed in the pan for latent prints.

The video collected from Puga has been attached to this report.

My BWC was activated during this incident.

Upon conclusion of the initial investigation, it was determined there were no reports of gun shots being heard just reports of weapons being seen.

On 6/1/18, I was provided information about an unknown subject who was identified as being a part of the disturbance at the Keys. I was provided an alias of "Tay Bang" and began conducting searches within Law Enforcement Databases to reveal his true identity. I was able to positively identify "Tay Bang" as Devante Cartez Zachery, of Gainesville, FL and determine that he did not affiliate with UF in any manner.

Additional information obtained from Det. Henderson's investigation revealed that Zachery was at the Keys

complex during this incident and has been involved with an on-going dispute with some UF students.

On 6/6/18, I was able to make contact with Zachery at his place of employment, Enterprise Rent-a-Car, located at the Williston Road and SW 34th Street intersection. When I spoke to Zachery, he admitted to being at the Keys during the night in question and admitted that there had been an ongoing dispute between him and some UF students since February 2018. He stated that it began at an off-campus club, the Gold Room. Zachery stated that it initially began with some joking around, but has since become more aggressive.

Zachery identified two UF students as the main culprit in the ongoing dispute: C'Yontai Lewis and Luke Ancrum.

Zachery mentioned that on Memorial Day, he and his friend Jarvis Walker were on UF's campus visiting an unknown female at her dorm (at the Keys). Zachery stated that later in the day he and his friend noticed several members of the football team outside the window of the room they were in and recognized him from the Gold Room. Zachery stated, within a few minutes they noticed about 15 more members of the football team, so they decided to leave.

Zachery stated that he observed one football player in possession of some sort of assault rifle and some others were holding rocks. I asked Zachery if he was in possession of a weapon and he stated no, but informed me that he does have a permit to carry. I asked him if he had it in his vehicle and he said no, and mentioned that he did not have a firearm yet.

I do not accept Zachery's story to be completely true and could determine that he was minimizing the incidents he was describing.

I advised Zachery that he was being trespassed from All University of Florida properties for a period of three years. Zachery stated that he understood the trespass and the consequences of returning to campus.

Shortly after I completed my interview with Zachery, I noticed that he had posted the following on his Facebook page: "Damn the University of Florida got some bitch ass football players."

On June 1st at approximately 1300 hours, I meet with UF Athletic Department Director of Student Athlete Development Vernell Brown, UF student athlete David Reese, and UF student athlete Thaddeus Dean at the University of Florida Police Department (UFPD) Criminal Investigation Division (CID) to discuss the incident that occurred at the Keys complex on Monday, the 28th of May.

I first spoke with Reese in the CID interview room. We spoke briefly about various topics not related to the incident and I advised him this was not a custodial interview and I was hoping to gain knowledge about what had occurred that night. Reese said he and several other UF student athletes went over to the dorm room of UF student athlete Emory Jones, who lives in building 6 room 103 of the Keys Complex at approximately 1645 hours. When Reese was outside the glass door attempting to enter building 6, three unknown black males in their twenties and a light skinned female were standing outside. One of the black males asked Reese if they have seen Tyrie Cleveland, who is also a UF student athlete. Reese stated no and was let inside the building by the unknown light skinned female who must reside in the building. Once inside they began playing video games and joking around with Jones saying the males waiting outside were looking for him and he should go talk to them.

Reese said fellow student athlete Dean who resides in the dorm room with Jones arrived home and he also observed the males waiting outside the building 6. Reese said they left the dorm room at an unknown time, but when the sun was going down, and went south towards the parking lot of Flavet and meet with several members of the football team. Then all the teammates walk north on Woodlawn/Flavet Field and confront the individuals waiting. The individuals got into their vehicles and began to drive away. Reese said he could hear a male from one of the vehicles say "We coming back strapped." Reese described the vehicles as a newer model red Jaguar, Mercedes Benz, and black Chevy Cruz.

Reese said he and his teammates went into Jones dorm room in building 6 and began to watch basketball. At some point, Dean looked out the window and saw the individuals from earlier and their cars. Reese thought Dean observed one of the individuals with a gun so they all got low to the floor. They took turns exiting out of one of the windows from the dorm room. Once they got out of the window, Reese observed a black male holding a baseball bat. Reese and his teammates ran and later confronted the unknown males. Reese said he noticed a red "laser" being pointed at one of his teammates Kevin Gamble's chest. Reese said several teammates confronted the males and he heard a male from the other group yell "Come any closer, I'll spray you." Reese could hear police sirens so, everyone involved left the area.

When recapping my conversation with Reese, he said at one point in the night while inside Jones' dorm room, he looked at the window and noticed one of the three males had a pistol in his possession. Reese described the pistol as a black semi-automatic handgun. Reese said he does not know the individuals personally, but knows one of the black males in the red Jaguar was "Tay Bang." Reese believes this is an ongoing incident involving local black males and football players for UF. Reese said Kadarius Toney and he believes a teammate named "Kyree" were the individuals with the airsoft guns.

I then spoke with Dean explaining to him this was a noncustodial interview and I was hoping to gain information related to the night in question. Dean said he was in Atlanta for the weekend and had returned to his dorm room in building 6 room 103 of the Keys Complex. Dean advised he is roommates with Emory Jones. When he approached building 6, he noticed several black males standing outside the building by there vehicles. Dean could see one of the black males near a newer model red Jaguar had a firearm in his possession. A black male asked if Dean was a football player. Dean said no and began to enter the building. Dean could hear them talking about Emory Jones as he walked into the building. When he was inside the dorm room, Dean asked if they males outside were family with Jones. Jones said no and Reese said they have been there since "2 pm."

At that point Dean, Reese and several other teammates inside his dorm room went out the other entrance to building 6 and then ran away from the area. They eventually made their way down to the parking lot to the south of Flavet Field. Once there many teammates had arrived and they walk up to confront the males who were parked waiting. When those males observed the large number of teammates coming towards them, they got into their vehicles and left the area. Dean remembered hearing someone yell they were coming back and they would not be alone.

The teammates then go inside Dean's dorm room to watch the game. Someone went to the window and noticed the same individuals had parked their vehicle very close to the windows of their dorm room inside building 6. Dean remembered seeing the red Jaguar, a Mercedes Benz, Chevy Cruz, and possibly a Nissan Altima. Dean said he believes the cars are rental cars. All the individuals inside immediately got low to the ground. They went into the empty bedroom and took turns exiting out of the window onto the grass. When Dean exited, he could see a black male holding a metal baseball bat. According to Dean, the last person out of the window was a larger male who could barely fit and he was worried the male holding the bat was going to strike him. No one was hurt and they all ran towards the small parking lot of the Keys Complex, just north of Flavet Field and confronted the males. Dean said the males in the vehicles then moved their cars away from building 6 and parked them near the parking spots on Woodlawn near Flavet Field. Dean said he never got close to where the groups of males were arguing, but believes one of his teammates named Kevin Gamble had some type of "laser" pointed on his chest. Gamble began to yell they got guns and everyone begins to run, plus they could hear the sounds of police sirens coming to the area. Dean side everyone went to various locations, but he called one his cousins who is also a teammate on the phone. His cousin said he was being followed by the individuals in the red Jaguar, but was able to "lose" it. Dean, Reese and another teammate went to the apartment of a fellow teammate near midtown and had no incidents since that night. Dean said he was sure that one of the black males in the red Jaguar was "Tay Bang."

On June 5th, Lt. Summers and I met with Gainesville Attorney Ron Kozlowski in Lt. Summers' office. Kozlowski was there representing two UF student athletes, Kadarius Toney and Kyree Campbell. We spoke briefly about the incident and advised I would need to see the airsoft guns and compare them to the video to ensure Toney and Campbell were not in possession of real firearms while on campus. There was a discussion about who would take possession of the airsoft rifles with UFPD standpoint of ensuring they were not going to be on campus. It should be noted that both Toney and Campbell do not live on campus and the airsoft guns were in their or someone else vehicle the night of the incident, but were intentionally brought to campus the night of the incident. It was agreed that UF Vernell Brown, who was currently in possession of the airsoft guns, would continue to hold onto them (without a victim, UFPD was not going to collect the guns as evidence of a crime).

I then spoke with Toney in the interview room with Kozlowski was present. I explained the interview room to him and we discussed how one of UFPD's officer was near the location of the incident and if he would have seen Toney or Campbell holding the airsoft guns that look like real rifles from a distance, the situation could have been tragic. When then began talking about the incident. Toney said this all goes back from football players dealing with local males when they go downtown to the clubs/bars. The local males will try to fight the football players. On the night in question, Toney received a phone call requesting his help with the males parked outside building 6. The caller said there was a female named "Dasia" (unknown spelling) who was telling the males where the

football players live. Toney had the bb gun/airsoft rifle with him when he came to campus. The unknown males got into their car and left the area. Toney said they observed a UFPD vehicle driving west on Stadium Rd and attempted to flag them down, but the driver did not see them.

Toney said he did not see any of the other males with a firearm. Toney was outside of building 6 when he noticed his teammates climbing out of a window. One of the teammates climbing out of the window told Toney the males were back. Toney looked over and then ran to his vehicle to get the airsoft rifle. Toney said "Tay Bang" is a person who is always trying to cause problems with football players.

Next I spoke with Campbell with Kozlowski present in the interview room. I had the same conversation with Campbell about the possibility of how this could have been a tragic incident. We then began talking about the incident and he said he received a phone call from other teammates who were on campus asking for his help. Campbell grabbed his bb gun/airsoft rifle and drove to campus. When Campbell arrived on campus he observed a few males near a red Jaguar and a large group of his fellow teammates. The red Jaguar leaves the area and he goes inside Jones and Dean's dorm room to hang out. Campbell said when you are inside the dorm room someone looked out the living room window which faces out into the hallway inside building 6 and observed several of the males inside the building. Campbell said they believe "Dasia" had let them inside the building and they were looking for the players. Campbell said they all "hit the deck." They decided to exit out a window located in the dorm that lead outside to the lawn in hopes that the individuals inside would not see them. Campbell said he was the last person out and it was difficult for him to fit through the window. Campbell observed the individual holding the baseball bat when he exited the window. Campbell and the others ran towards Flavet Field and confronted the males. Campbell says Cleveland was out in the field arguing with the males and that's when he and Toney ran onto the field with the airsoft guns. C'yontai Lewis was holding the skillet during the incident. Campbell said once they saw the "laser" on one of his teammates, they all ran away. Campbell said he observed a red Jaguar and a white Mercedes Benz leave with the unknown males. Campbell said one of his teammates was being chased by one of the vehicles, but they were able to get away.

After the interviews, I spoke with Vernell Brown who was waiting in the lobby and advised him I need to inspect the airsoft rifles. Brown said it would not be a problem and he would contact me to arrange a time.

A short time later, Brown called and Detective Peterson and I met with him at his vehicle located in the lower south parking lot of Ben Hill Griffin Stadium to view the airsoft rifles. After inspecting each one, I confirmed them to be plastic airsoft rifles. The one rifle made to look like an AR15, which Toney was carrying, had the orange tip mostly painted black making it look even more like a real riddle. The other airsoft rifle matched that as seen in the video being carried by Campbell. It looks more like an AK style rifle, but still had the orange tip. Both this airsoft rifles appeared to be "real" rifles when visually inspected. It is not until you hold or closely inspect them you discover the orange type on the one and light weight plastic feel of each. I photographed the airsoft rifles and attached the photos to this report. I spoke with Brown again about not having these types of airsoft rifles on campus, especially when they are being displayed as if they are "real" semi-automatic weapons. Brown assured me they would not be seen on campus again.

When I spoke with Reese, Dean, Toney, and Campbell, I advised them to contact law enforcement immediately when a situation like this happens and to not attempt to take matters into their own hands.

All interviews were recorded and a copy will be placed into evidence in the near future.

I called and spoke with Puga who made the video. He said he has had no issues with anyone and was appreciative of our efforts to conduct a thorough investigation.


I still have two interviews that will be conducted in the near future with individuals who may have additional information of the original reason why Devante Zachery aka "Tay Bang" came to the UF campus looking for football players.

Both Toney and Campbell are recommended to SCCR in reference for their involvement in the incident by holding and pointing what appears to be assault rifles (later determined to be airsoft rifles) at other individuals on campus. By having these airsoft rifles on campus and displaying them to individuals whom other teammates said to have what they believed to be "real" firearms, put themselves, teammates, responding police officers and anyone in the area in harm's way. It should be noted that both Toney and Campbell were cooperative during my interview and appeared to be remorseful in what they did that night.

Cleveland, Wells, Gamble and Jones are recommended to SCCR for being untruthful to UFPD Officers who were interviewing them the night of the incident. If at least one of them would have cooperated with police, the incident could have been resolved faster and not put police officers and other individuals living on campus in danger. It should be noted that Wells was not cooperate and was untruthful to a UFPD Detective during an investigation (17-1225).

This case is still active.

On June 15, 2018 at approximately 1300 hours, Vernell Brown brought Tyrie Cleveland, C'yontai Lewis, and Luke Ancrum to UFPD to speak with about the incident on May 28th. I first spoke with Cleveland in the interview room. We spoke briefly about the interview room and how he was not a suspect in a criminal investigation. I asked Cleveland to tell me about issues related to the incident on May 28th. Cleveland said in the past, he has seen and heard of other teammates having issues with local males' downtown. He did not know a reason why, he said it was just "hating." The night of the incident on campus, Cleveland came because he had been told by teammates unknown individuals had been waiting outside a dorm room for hours. Once there they confronted the males and they left the area. Cleveland said he did not see any firearms or lasers being pointed at anyone. Cleveland said one of the individuals was "Tay Bang." I asked Cleveland why he didn't tell UFPD Officers who spoke with him the night of the incident about what really happened. Cleveland said he wanted to speak with his coaches first. I told Cleveland about SCCR and how he and the other student athletes who spoke with UFPD

Officers the night of the incident are being referred.

Next I spoke with Lewis in the interview room. I explained he was not there as a suspect for a criminal investigation, but I asked him to tell me about the night in question. Lewis was very familiar with "Tay Bang" and said he had seen him out downtown and even on campus during the Orange and Blue game. Lewis said he is a 5th year player and had a good relationship with "Tay Bang" and other local males until fall of 2017. Lewis said it started out well when the football team was winning, but when they began losing, "Tay Bang" would call them "garbage" and would complain about losing money after he would bet on the football games. Lewis said he stopped associating with "Tay Bang." On May 25th, Lewis came to the Keys Complex with other teammates. He said there was lots of yelling between the two groups, but he did not see any firearms.

Lastly I spoke with Luke Ancrum. As will the other interviewees, I told Ancrum he was not a suspect in a criminal investigation, but how his name was mentioned while conducting interviews about the incident on May 28th. Ancrum advised he was not there on May 28th and had only heard about what had happened. Ancrum said he had no idea who "Tay Bang" was and said he never had any issues with anyone downtown, but had heard of other teammates having problems. Ancrum said he lived with Lewis last fall, so that must be reason someone would say his name with Lewis since they lived and went out sometimes together.

I reviewed all videos supplied by the UF Department of Housing. There are cameras on the Keys Complex buildings/dorm rooms, but they only face towards the entrances of each building (two per building). There are two cameras which face outwards to the walkways on the Keys Complex Common Area building. For the camera that faces the north entrance for building 6, I watched the video from 1330 hours until 2200 hours for May 28th. While watching the video, you can see a reflection of a small portion of the parking lot located just north of the building. In the reflection, you are not able to make out any individuals, but can see people walking and the roofs of several unidentifiable vehicles that are parked. The vehicle parked in the first parking space closest to the north entrance appears to be red in color (possibly the red Jaguar). During the video, you see a couple of unknown UF students enter and leave the building. At 1926 hours, Tray Dean and an unknown black male with a suitcase arrive and enter the building. As they come in and out of the building to unload their belongings, you can see the reflection of an unknown black male wearing dark clothing, tan shoes or boots, and has a white towel or rag over his head and then shoulders walking back and forth. You can see in the reflection of the glass at 1929 hours, the unknown black male then enters the red vehicle parked in the first parking spot and backs the vehicle out and leaves. At 2020 hours, Dean opens the door and begins to look outside while also checking his cell phone. Dean goes back inside then quickly leaves with David Reese, and an unknown black male (possibly Reese's roommate) following behind him. Several UF student athletes come and go from the building, but at 2106 hours, you can barely make out in the reflection of the glass, several individuals, possibly black males, wearing white shirts walk by. At 2129 hours, when you observe a large group of black males standing and then entering the building. This group are all UF student athletes (football team members) with UF. Based on the timeframe, this is when the teammates, met up near Flavet Field and confronted "Tay Bang" and a few others in the red Jaguar, and then go into Emory Jones and Tray Dean's dorm room to watch the basketball game. At 2137 hours, Kadarius Toney and Tyrie Cleveland exit the building. At 2141 hours, Rick Wells opens the north door and looks outside while holding his cell phone. At 2144 hours, a large group of UF student athletes exit the building in a hurry. Emory Jones and another unidentified black male stay near the door and look around

cautiously and then leave camera view at 2145 hours. At 2146 hours, Jones returns running inside after opening the door. At 2148 hours, Jones, and two unknown UF student athletes leave, with one of them using a shirt to cover his face. At 2150 hours, Jones and the unknown male covering his face return and go inside the building. No one else is seen entering or leaving the building when the video ends at 2200 hours. Jones scanned entries into the north entrance of building 6 were also verified with UF Housing.

This video is also how I was able to identify Kadarius Toney as one of the individuals holding an airsoft rifle in the cell phone video captured by Sebastian Puga (2129 hours). At no time during the video did I observe anyone come to the north door entrance and attempt to get inside that did not appear to be a UF student or a UF student athlete. I also did not see a female intentionally let anyone inside the building.

I watched the video from the surveillance camera facing the building 6 south entrance from 1330 hours to 2200 hours. I observed a few UF students properly enter the building throughout the day. At 2111 hours, Lewis, Wells, Cleveland, and two unknown black males come to the south door and wait for someone to let them inside. At 2112 hours, they leave the area and out of camera view. At 2129 hours, you can see Cleveland and several other black males now inside building 6 near the stairwell. They disappear from view very quickly. There is nothing observed until 2141 hours when in the reflection of the glass, you can see a car's headlights pull in and a dark in color newer model car (newer style taillights) back into the parking lot near the building. You are able to see shadows of several individuals on the ground. The vehicles leave at 2144 hours, which coincides with the large group of UF student athletes exiting building 6 from the north entrance. You can see an unknown person look out the glass door from inside building 6 very quickly, but then goes out of view. Nothing else is observed on the camera beside UFPD patrol vehicle blue and red lights reflecting off the walls.

At no time in the video did I observe anyone enter building 6 who did not appear to be a UF student or a UF student athlete. At 2133 hours, a black female leaves through the north entrance of building 6 allowing an unknown black male access into the building. This black male is believed to be a UF student athlete and is seen again with the large group of student athletes later in the video. I did not observe anyone let a group of nonaffiliated UF black males inside the building as reported by several UF student athletes that I interviewed.

Increase patrols were requested by Sgt. Moran for the Keys Complex. There have been no reported issues on campus since the night of May 28th.

I spoke with a representative with Enterprise rental and they said they do not rent luxury vehicles like the ones observed the night of the incident. They did not know of a local company that did rent luxury vehicles in our area.

At this time, only Devante Cartez Zachery, "Tay Bang," has been issued a trespass warning for all UF properties. Since the airsoft rifles were determined not to be a firearm and no one has contacted UFPD claiming to be a victim, this case will remain as an information report. As described in my first supplement report, several UF student athletes have been referred to SCCR. All videos from UF Department of Housing have been placed into evidence for safe keeping. I do believe great strides have been made to increase a better relationship with these student athletes so that they feel comfortable in reporting incidents to law enforcement when they arise.

This case is closed.
